- Discussion of possible funding to allow The Retired to have a table space at ESP and Higher Ed Conferences in order to promote membership
- Summit will be March 7-9, 2025 at the Huntington Place in Detroit
- Retired Conference will be March 9-11 at the Fort Pontchartrain Hotel in Detroit
- Beginning in 2027 the Retired Conference will be "decoupled" from the Summit
 This action is a positive thing-will allow both groups more autonomy
- We are further along in the fight to repeal GPO/WEP than we ever have been Senate version has 62 co-sponsors/House is essentially a done deal Main obstacle is time-we have only NOV/DEC to deal with NEA has been lobbying for 30 years on this issue Could save the government 2 BILLION in SNAP benefits over 10 years
